\***Project** work will be accepted up to one week past the project deadline for full credit if work ethic is 100%. Weekly drawing challenges and It's Learning assignments will not be accepted late (only for excused absence).

\*Project work may be submitted up to two weeks past the project deadline for 50% credit.

\*Work will NOT be accepted if it is submitted more than two weeks beyond the project deadline.

\*All work must be submitted in the proper location or the proper procedure to ensure that you receive maximum credit.

\*If a student does not submit a project on the deadline, a grade of ZERO will be entered until the student submits the work.

\*Extra credit will not be offered.

\*To earn additional points, students may revisit/revise any project within the QUARTER based on the feedback received. A student may also completely redo a project, should they choose to do so. NO revisits or do-overs will be accepted the last week of the quarter.
