A. Project Criteria/Directions: Student chose an appropriate subject. The photo is large, and up close. The vantage point is interesting. If the subject is human, the student has taken the picture (not downloaded from the Internet).

B. Creativity & Originality: Subject choice is innovative and not cliché. Color scheme promotes emphasis and contrast. It adds to the subject matter and is an integral part of the painting. Color pencil lines emphasize the contours and highlight important areas without simply outlining the subject.
